Work Capital Innovation Fund (WCIF) is the leading early-stage impact venture fund focused on supply chain innovations that improve outcomes for vulnerable workers. The Fund's goal is to reduce the most severe forms of labor exploitation by accelerating the development and deployment of supply chain solutions that offer greater transparency and accountability into corporate operations. Launched in 2017, WCIF has deployed over US\$16 million to start-ups across the globe through its first Fund and is actively deploying its second Fund (expected over \$50 million assets under management) to scale our work and create a larger footprint for "S" within ESG. The Fund was originally launched and incubated within [Humanity United](#), a private foundation that is part of [The Omidyar Group \("TOG"\)](#). JOB SUMMARY

We are currently recruiting a Summer Associate who will be based in Washington, DC or San Francisco, CA. The role is highly entrepreneurial, offering exposure to global venture investing, consulting/management, and entrepreneurship, with a focus on investing in cutting edge innovations that make supply chains more ethical and transparent. Successful candidates will have the opportunity to work on live deals and will work with our team to define a meaningful project and deliverable (e.g., sector report, market overview) to complete during the internship period.
